How to use this form

1. The loading driver begins the record when the reefer is PRE-TRIP INSPECTED.
2. If the loaded trailer is spotted at the origin terminal yard, leave the temperature card a guard or supervisor who will have the load checked every 4 hours until departure. Keep this record with the load paperwork.
3. If the load is spotted at the destination terminal yard, leave the temperature card with a guard or supervisor who will have the load checked every 4 hours until delivery. This record stays with the load paper work.
6. The Delivering driver should comment on load condition and turn in the temperature card with the pod in the trip envelope.

Here is how to have a trouble free trip.

1. Before doing a pre trip inspection on the reefer trailer, press the pre trip button on the reefer. Record any codes that appear. Cancel the codes and start and set the reefer as per dispatch temperature inspection.
2. Do your pre trip on the reefer trailer. This gives the reefer unit 5 minutes to run. Look for error codes again. Look up any error codes that display to determine if you need help or if you can handle the error.
3. After loading stop and check your temperatures in 60 to 90 minutes. If the box temperature is not moving towards the set temperature, you need to defrost the unit or you may have a more serious problem.
